RULES OF COMPETITION:

Teams are made of 7 players.

All the players on the pitch must be an employee, collaborator or subcontractor of the company.

Squads may be a maximum of 15 players.

Games will last 15 minutes, in two halves.

Unlimited substitutions may be made in each match

The games will be refereed by independent referees, mostly or all from AMF (Asociatia Municipala de Fotbal).

The top two teams from each group go through to the quarter-finals.

If two teams have equal points, goal difference will decide. If still equal, number of goals will decide.

In the knock out stage a drawn game will be decided by penalties.

The tournament organizers will apply the rules at their discretion, ensuring that all teams enjoy the

day and that the result of the tournament is fair.
